Subject: Revising Policy Regarding Internationally Trained Physicians and Supporting Legislation that Facilitates Licensure of Internationally Trained Physicians

4 WHEREAS, there is both an interest and a need for such physicians in Oregon to serve our
5 communities in as many clinical settings that are feasibly possible, now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That the OAFP advocate to the Oregon Medical Board to revise its current policy
7 regarding internationally trained physicians to facilitate licensure of internationally trained physicians to
8 practice medicine in Oregon, and BE IT FURTHER

9 RESOLVED, That the OAFP support legislation that facilitates licensure of internationally trained
10 physicians to practice medicine in Oregon
